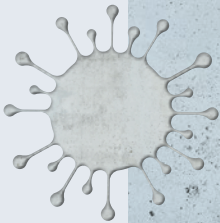

ChargeX wins awards, finances itself and advances the mobility revolution

The Charger-Infrastructure start-up ChargeX concludes its crowdfunding with considerable success and raises one million euros. The initial funding goal of 100,000 euros was exceeded rapidly. This capital is invested to meet the increasing demand for charging points. Here, students supported by Amazon Web Services (AWS) worked together with stakeholders from the public sector on concrete problems in the field of digitization. The topics ranged from support for Alzheimer's sufferers to the classification of tree species. The DTLab Cloud

Summer Camp, which took place for the second time in 2020, offered 200 participants a four-day introduction to AWS for innovators.

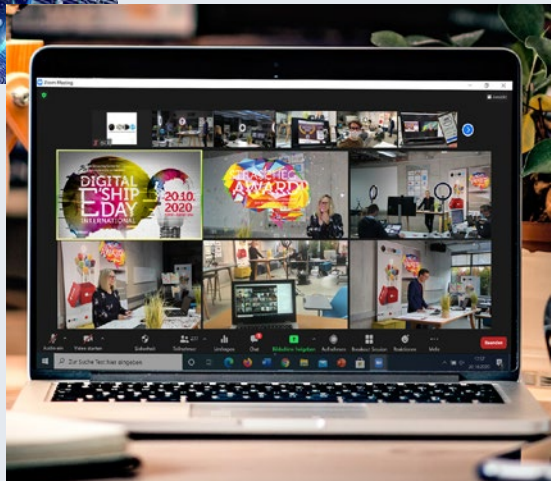
