






















The SCE was founded in 2002 by the Prof. Falk F. Strascheg Foundation at the Munich University of Applied Sciences. Prof. Falk F. Strascheg is one of the most successful venture capitalists in Germany and Europe and is a founding partner of the venture capital company EXTOREL Private Equity Advisers. Prof. Falk F. Strascheg has been many things in his life. To limit it to his career, he's been an engineer, founder, entrepreneur, venture capitalist, supervisory board member, industry association head and, last but not least, donor and patron. His wife Renate Strascheg also has very close ties to the SCE. Since 2014, the Renate and Falk Strascheg Foundation has been sponsoring the Strascheg Award for innovations at the Munich University of Applied Sciences.
